

9 Days - Al-Aqsa & Jordan

ITINERARY

DAY 1 – SINGAPURA – AMMAN

Gather at Changi Airport for the flight to Amman, Jordan. Prepare to begin a spiritual journey tracing the footsteps of the Prophets with hearts full of hope and reliance upon Allah.

DAY 2 – AMMAN

After breakfast, visit the **Blessed Tree**, traditionally linked to the childhood journey of Rasulullah. Along the way, stop at **Azraq** to view the remains of the Umayyad Castle. Return to Amman for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 3 – AMMAN – JERICHO – JERUSALEM

Check out from the hotel and cross the border via **Allenby Bridge**. Visit **Jericho**, followed by **Maqam Nabi Musa**. Experience the **Dead Sea** before continuing the journey to **Jerusalem**. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 4 – JERUSALEM – BAITUL MAQDIS

The day is dedicated to a full visit of the sacred Baitul Maqdis area, including Masjid Al-Aqsa and its surrounding holy sites. Pilgrims will also visit Maqam Nabi Dawood and Masjid Khalifah Omar, followed by a walk through the Old City and local markets. Dinner and overnight stay will be in Jerusalem.

DAY 5 – HEBRON – BETHLEHEM – MOUNT OF OLIVES

The journey continues to Hebron, where pilgrims will perform prayers at Masjid Al-Ibrahimi and visit Maqam Nabi Yunus. Proceed to Bethlehem for prayers at Masjid Omar. Later, enjoy panoramic views of Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives and visit several significant maqams before returning to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 6 – JAFFA

Pilgrims will explore the historic Islamic city of Jaffa, visiting its old city area, mosques, clock tower and port. The visit also includes sites associated with Nabi Yunus, along with free time to explore the local market and seaside area. The day ends with a return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 7 – JERUSALEM – MU'TA – PETRA

After checking out, the group returns to Jordan via Allenby Bridge. A stop will be made in Mu'ta to visit the maqams of the great companions who were martyred in the Battle of Mu'ta. The journey then continues to Petra, where pilgrims will rest and stay overnight.

DAY 8 – PETRA – AMMAN

The day begins with a visit to Petra, the ancient city famously known as the Rose City, carved into red sandstone cliffs. After the visit, the group travels back to Amman for transfer to the airport in preparation for the return flight.

DAY 9 – AMMAN – SINGAPURA

The journey concludes with arrival back in Singapore. May this spiritually enriching journey leave lasting memories, deepen faith, and inspire continued reflection long after returning home.
